Overnight Boarding Addendum

This Boarding Addendum supplements the Kim's Dog House Client Agreement and Dog Intake Form and applies only to dogs participating in overnight or extended boarding services.

Boarding Services

Boarding services include overnight care, feeding, supervision, and routine handling in accordance with Kim's Dog House policies and Rhode Island regulations. Dogs may participate in daycare activities during boarding unless otherwise restricted.

Additional Health & Vaccination Requirements

In addition to daycare requirements, all boarding dogs must:

- Have current **Rabies, DHPP, and Bordetella vaccinations**
- Provide **veterinary vaccination records** prior to boarding
- Be free from illness, parasites, and communicable disease at check-in

Kim's Dog House reserves the right to refuse or discontinue boarding if a dog shows signs of illness or poses a health risk.
